All stakeholders, especially students are required to be aware of this code / policy and comply with it.

**Summary of the Policy:**

**1. Defines Behavior Standards:**

- **Positive Behavior:** Expected actions (worth 80 marks)
- **Exemplary Behavior:** Above-and-beyond actions (worth 20 marks)

**2. Monitors & Evaluates Student Behavior:**

- Observation by teachers, counselors, SLT
- Behavioral offenses categorized into **4 degrees:**
  - 1st: Minor (e.g., lateness, uniform)
  - 2nd: Moderate (e.g., skipping school)
  - 3rd: Serious (e.g., bullying)
  - 4th: Severe (e.g., drugs, assault)

**3. Behavior Management Committee Involvement:**

- Discuss offenses
- Assign corrective actions
- Refer to external agencies if needed

**4. Behavior Improvement Support:**

- Expected Behaviour Plan
- Guardian involvement
- Referral to support centers (e.g., counseling, psychiatric, social work)

**5. Outcomes:**

- Students may be promoted, retained, or expelled based on behavior

For KG to Grade 2, the code is modified by the school to monitor, and progress positive student behaviour.
